- 1, 2 Consistent with the needs of smaller businesses, the IBM Lotus Domino Express license restrictions remove Lotus Notes and Domino elements and attributes most appropriate for larger enterprises. Thus, the following attributes are not included in the IBM Lotus Domino Messaging Express or IBM Lotus Domino Collaboration Express license:
- Lotus Domino partitioning capabilities
  - Lotus Domino clustering capabilities
  - Option to use IBM DB2® software as an alternative data store
  - Limited use entitlement to IBM WebSphere® Application Server software that is provided with IBM Lotus Domino Enterprise Server and Lotus Domino Utility Server software (Note: IBM WebSphere Application Server Express software is available separately.)
  - IBM System z™ hardware use entitlement, including Linux on System z technology (Note: All other Lotus Domino platforms, including Microsoft Windows 2000 or 2003, Linux on Intel® processor-based systems, i5/OS, AIX and Solaris operating environments are entitled.)
  - Lotus Notes access for SAP solutions feature of Lotus Notes software
- Certain administration functions are also restricted by the IBM Lotus Domino Express license, including extended access control lists, cascading directories, directory catalogs, directory assistance and central directory (userless name and address book).
- 3 Use of integrated Web conferencing features in Lotus Domino Messaging Express and Lotus Domino Collaboration Express software requires a separate license of IBM Lotus Sametime® software.
- 4 For Lotus Domino Utility Server Express software, you acquire server licenses determined by the total processor value units associated with your server machine(s), up to a maximum of 400 processor value units per company. Consistent with the needs of smaller businesses, the IBM Lotus Domino Express license restrictions remove Lotus Domino elements and attributes most appropriate for larger enterprises. Thus, the following attributes are not included in the IBM Lotus Domino Utility Server Express license:
- Option to use IBM DB2 software as an alternative data store
  - Limited use entitlement to IBM WebSphere Application Server software that is provided with IBM Lotus Domino Enterprise Server and Lotus Domino Utility Server software (Note: IBM WebSphere Application Server Express software is available separately.)
  - Entitlement to IBM Lotus Domino Document Manager and IBM Lotus Workflow™ software that is part of IBM Lotus Domino Utility Server software
  - IBM System z hardware use entitlement, including Linux on System z technology (Note: All other Lotus Domino platforms, including Microsoft Windows 2000 or 2003, Linux on Intel processor-based systems, i5/OS, AIX and Solaris operating environments are entitled.)
